


Not only did the director of Pune firm Design Directions win his third straight award, he also won three individual awards this year.

This year, Satish and his firm designed a sleek micro

hardness testing machine for Pune firm Chroma Systems and a colour doppler ultra sound machine for Larsen and Toubro.
